Eligibility Criteria

- ❖ A graduate of an Arizona High School and paying out-of-state tuition at ASU
- ❖ An enrolled student at Arizona State University for the 2010-11 academic school year.
- ❖ Currently have a 2.5 GPA or higher, to be verified in during the review process.
- ❖ Upon acceptance, commit to volunteer time with the Loving Neighbor Scholarship program.

Please write an essay (500 word maximum) addressing the following questions:

- ❖ How have you demonstrated neighborly love in your community?
- ❖ How will you utilize your education to continue demonstrating it?
